

# OPEN YOUTH EXHIBITS

- Open to all junior residents of Imperial County, between the ages of 5 and 19 (exhibitor age as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the fair year.); individuals, members of organizations, classes, schools, etc. Primary: 5- to 8-year-olds; Junior: 9- to 12-year-olds or in the 4<sup>th</sup> grade; Intermediate: 13- to 14-year-olds, not in high school; Advanced: 14- to 19-year-olds.
- All entries for the Junior Exhibits must be made on official entry forms furnished by the Fair. The exhibitor, parent or guardian, and leader, teacher, or advisor, if applicable must sign each form.
- All State and Local rules are applicable to the Junior Exhibit Department.
- All entries must be completed within one year of fair date, unless otherwise noted.
- Two systems of judging will be used:

**American System** - In this system, each exhibit is judged not only on its own merit, but in comparison to other exhibits using score cards prepared by the State Division of Fairs and Expositions, and Fair Management.

**Danish System** - In this system, each exhibit is judged based upon established standards of quality per the Danish System Score Card. Each exhibit is judged according to how well it meets the standard, rather than how it compares with other exhibits. The following guidelines shall be used by Danish System Judges:

Quality	Scoring	Ribbon	Quality	Scoring	Ribbon
Superior	92%-100%	Blue	Average	70%-83%	White
Good	84%-91%	Red	Poor	69% and less	None

- Extraordinary exhibit of remarkable talent and workmanship may be awarded a purple ribbon. This ribbon shall be paid the blue ribbon premium but will carry an additional point for the purposes of scoring high point and sweepstakes.

## FAIR THEME AWARDS

- Only Junior, Intermediate or Advanced Exhibitors are eligible for the Fair Theme Awards.
- To be considered, the item entered must, at least, demonstrate the average skill level expected from the age group of the child who has entered.
- Each exhibitor is limited to three (3) items to be considered for this award.
- Exhibitor must enter Fair Theme Awards on a separate entry form.

1. No paraffin seals.
2. All canning exhibits must be in sealed standard canning jars. Standard jars are those containers specifically designed for canning purposes.
3. Non-acid foods: All vegetables, meats, poultry, and fish must be canned under pressure.
4. Low-acid foods: Fruits such as figs, should be made more acidic by adding lemon juice, as directed in the University of California, Agricultural Extension Service leaflet "Home Canning of Fruits".
5. Tomatoes and fruits (not including their juices) must be

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- processed in a boiling water bath.
6. Jar sizes: **Fruits and Vegetables** - clear glass, wide or narrow mouth Mason jar; **Jellies** - clear glass, standard 7-12 ounce jelly jar; **Jams** - clear glass, pints or half pints, fruit jars only; **Syrups** - clear glass, half pint or larger.
  7. All entries must have two jars of the specified size. One jar for sampling, one jar for display. Each properly labeled with product date and process.
