

New for 2012 Fair (and future fairs) FIRST RIGHT OF REFUSAL - Each camper will select their RV space from a map in the fair’s administration office on a **first come-first serve** basis, please see the selection schedule below. Once your spot has been confirmed for the 2012 Fair, it will be your RV’s assigned space for subsequent fairs. For example, if you have spot #11 in 2012, Space #11 will be considered your spot for the 2013 fair and following fairs as long as you comply with RV Rules and Regulations, including payment deadlines.

- (1) Request specific RV space in person. Starting on January 27th at 10:00 a.m., you may come to the Fair’s administration office in person to sign up and pay for a specific RV space. At 10:00 a.m., we will wait on one person at a time starting with the first in line.
- (2) Request specific RV space by fax or email. After all those who are in line at the office have picked their space, we will then accept faxes and emails making every effort to go in the order received. Only completed forms with credit card information will be accepted. We encourage interested parties to go to the **FULL** RV lot to identify the exact spot they are interested in. One should also have alternate space numbers in mind in case their favorite space is taken. Map will be on the website by January (prior to January 27).
- (3) Arrive at the Fair. Campers can start to move in the full hook up areas during the times listed below. Everyone must park their RV in their designated spot **only**. No changes, unless pre-approved by Fair Management. No early line ups are necessary, as everyone has their space in advance.

- Gate Access - Please use the Stock Gate **only** to access the RV Lot.

- No advance line up is necessary as everyone has assigned spaces.

- All RVs need to be removed by 12:00 p.m. on Monday after the fair; contact IVE’s Administration Office for a late check-out.

- Fair management reserves the right to make changes to the map based on safety concerns or arising issues.

- For future fairs, your payment is due by October 1 each year.

There are a limited number of RV campsites available on the fairgrounds during the run of the annual California Mid-Winter Fair & Fiesta. We have two types of RV spaces available:

- (1) Full hookup sites are available in the RV Park located north of the wash racks – (30 amps)
- (2) Dry campsites will be in an area designated by Fair management. The number of Dry spaces may change each year depending on the fair’s programming.

Frequently Asked Questions

- (1) **How do I get the RV space that I want?**
Be at or near the front of the line on January 27 when you bring in your RV Reservation Request Form to the Fair's Administration office. We will wait on one applicant at a time. To speed things up, have your form completed with all the necessary information. Please note that not everyone wants or fits in the same spot.
- (2) **Can I hold a space for my friend who cannot make it on January 27?**
You can reserve up to 3 RV spaces at a time as long as each reservation has a completed RV Reservation Request Form with all the necessary information requested and payment is made.
- (3) **What if I cannot make it to the office, can I fax or email my RV Reservation Request Form to the Fair office? Is so, when will it be processed?**
First priority will be given to those who are in the administration office; faxed and emailed request forms will be processed **after** those that have been made in person. We will do our best to process them in the order they arrive.
- (4) **What if I did not get my first choice?**
The camper who has been assigned the space you desire has the opportunity to renew placement in that space until they no longer want to have an RV at the Fair, violate the rules, or fail to pay on time. Unfortunately, you need to park in the RV space that you did get assigned to. You may add your name on a waiting list for a specific spot. However, that spot will only be made available when the person who signed up for it does not want it or lost their privilege to camp.
- (5) **What if I forget and do not pay for my space by October 1st for the next year?**
Your space can be given to another interested party who was on the waiting list for that space. However, you are welcome to get whatever space may still be available to you.
- (6) **What if my RV space was in Dry camping last year and this year I want Full Hook-ups?**
Every RV space is first come-first serve for 2012, so if you are at the first of the line on January 27th, you may get the full hook-up spot you want.
- (7) **What if I decide that I do not want my spot, can I sell it to a friend?**
No, once you give up your RV spot, Fair Management will offer it to anyone who was on the waiting list for that spot. If no one is on the waiting list, Fair Management will then open that spot up to the next interested party.

There is a new procedure for securing livestock exhibitor RV space at the Fair. The RV spaces that are selected in advance for the 2012 Fair will have a **First Right of Refusal** for future fairs. For example, if RV Space #11 is picked, that camper will have RV Space #11 for all future fairs until they decide they do not want it, failed to pay on time or have violated the RV Rules and Regulations. The Fair office will be accepting request forms beginning **January 27, 2012**; please see timeline for more information. All fees must be paid at the time of request - no exceptions and no refunds. Fair management reserves the right to stop accepting requests at any time.

- Reservation must be in the name of the adult responsible for the campsite.
- Dry campsites **do not** have access to water, sewer or electrical hookups.
- Full hookup sites include water, sewer and electrical hookups. **Only 30 amp service provided.** If your RV unit trips the main service line breaker twice, you will be asked to remove the unit and leave the RV Park. No refunds.
- No electrical or extension cords are allowed in any walkway or aisle. For safety reasons, any cords in aisles will result in lost RV privileges.
- **Please note, since you have signed up for your RV Space in advance, there is no need to wait in line days before. All RVs must go into the space they previously signed up for. Any RV which is park in someone else's space will be asked to move. No advance line ups please.**
- Livestock Exhibitors Campsite access dates: Mon (2/27), Tue (2/28), and Wed (2/29). Policy: No admission to either campsite (dry or full) prior to Monday, February 27, 2011 at 6:00 a.m. **On Monday, 2/27 at 6:00 a.m., the Stock Gate only will be open for RVs. No RVs will be allowed on the fairgrounds prior to Monday, 2/27 at 6:00 a.m. Any vehicle on the facility prior to Monday at 6:00 a.m. will be subject to towing at owner's expense.**
- Full hookup campsites will receive **one** Parking Permit (to be placed in conspicuous location at front of vehicle) and **one** Parking Pass for personal vehicle parking in RV Park. Only one personal vehicle per RV Space allowed as long as it fits within designated space. If it does not, it must be parked in a designated space outside of the RV Park. All other vehicles must park in the overflow area.
- Full hookup RV's must be positioned where they will fit best in their designated space.
- Dry campsites will receive **one** Parking Permit (to be placed in conspicuous location at front of vehicle).
- The majority of our Dry RV sites are back-in sites. Campers are required to park to meet RV layout, safety and fire lane requirements.
- Campsites are for RV's only. Spaces may not be reserved to park additional vehicles.
- Parking passes are required for all vehicles entering campsites. Any unattended personal vehicles without parking passes parked in the RV Park will be towed at the owner's expense.
- No additional trailers or hauling rigs will be allowed in campsites.
- Speed limit is 5 MPH on all inside fairground roads. Drivers must obey all traffic rules and operate their vehicles in accordance with applicable Federal, State and local laws.
- All personal equipment and RV sites must be kept clean and neat within your assigned site.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed outside of RV space. Drugs, weapons, fighting, lewd conduct, reckless driving, speeding, motorized/non-motorized skateboards not permitted.
- No loud radios or music at any time: Quiet hours are between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. No loud talking or generators; please be considerate of others. Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated.
- Curfew is 11:00pm. All exhibitors need to be in their RV space at that time.
- No fires allowed: Fully contained barbecue grills and camping stoves are allowed.
- No littering: Littering of the RV Park, RV Site or RV Restrooms will not be tolerated. This includes smoking materials. Extinguish and properly dispose of all smoking materials in proper receptacles. Place garbage and litter in containers provided.
- RV's and all other vehicles must be removed from the grounds by 12 p.m. on Monday, March 12, 2012; otherwise, owner will incur a fee of \$50.00 per day until removed. Contact IVE's Administration Office for a late check-out.
- Any damage to any part of the IV Expo grounds, including fencing, will be charged to the camper and they will lose their camping privileges.

I hereby acknowledge that I have received and read IVE's Fairtime RV Rules and Regulations and accept responsibility for all occupants in the assigned RV space and that any violation of said policy or inappropriate actions will result in immediate removal from the RV Park and other action deemed appropriate by the Management and/or local law enforcement.
