Dear Prospective Jr. Fair Board Member:

Thank you, in advance, for applying to the California Mid-Winter Fair & Fiesta Junior Fair Board and good luck! It is a great way to meet kids from other schools and a wonderful way to serve your community. Junior Fair Board members have a lot of fun, but the work is hard. The following is a brief outline of the duties and responsibilities of the Junior Fair Board so you and your parents know in advance what is expected of you and the time that will be required.

The Junior Fair Board begins work in the fall with monthly meetings and appearances in local parades. In January meetings are held twice monthly and in February meetings are weekly until the opening of the Fair. The meetings begin at 7:00 pm and last 1-1½ hours. During the Fair meetings are held each afternoon to plan for the following day.

Work begins in earnest the week before the fair starts. Members can anticipate missing school Thursday afternoon and Friday for animal weigh-ins and more preparation. All day Saturday and Sunday you will be expected to work in the show rings. If you can't be around animals, this is not a job for you! If you have an animal at the fair, you will work around your show times. The following week, members will assist with School Tours and Special Peoples Day (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday) during the day. In the afternoons we meet and then sponsor activities until 9:00 pm or 10:00 pm. This is a very busy and tiring week. It is difficult to keep up the pace and your studies, too. Even the best student's grades can suffer. You are expected to participate in everything, so bear this in mind when you apply.

Junior Fair Board t-shirts, sweatshirts and jackets are provided for members. As representatives of the Fair, many people will closely scrutinize your behavior. Junior Fair Board members and their parents will be required to review and sign a *Code of Conduct* that will outline the expectations of Junior Fair Board members. Behavior deemed unacceptable by the Senior Fair Board or Junior Fair Board advisors may be cause for dismissal.

Interviews will be held on Wednesday, May 6<sup>th</sup> and Thursday, May 7<sup>th</sup>. You will be notified by telephone as to your exact interview time.

We look forward to meeting you at your interview. Please have a parent or guardian sign below and return this with your application to the Imperial Valley Expo office. This will verify that you and your parents understand what is expected of you if you are selected to serve a two-year term on the California Mid-Winter Fair & Fiesta Junior Fair Board.
