



GUACAMOLE CONTEST RULES - PROFESSIONAL

1. The California Mid-Winter Fair & Fiesta Guacamole Contest is not associated with any other Guacamole contest, and any other rules "DO NOT APPLY".
2. The grounds will be open on Thursday, March 6 at 4:00 PM, however contestants will be able to enter and set up their equipment, decorations, etc. at 2:30 PM. Entry instructions for contestants will be determined and communicated to the contestants by Saturday, March 1.
3. The chairperson will hold a meeting at 3:30 PM to give final instructions and answer questions. Prep work may start at 3:00 PM.
4. Be sure to supply ice chests and ice to keep Guacamole at appropriate temperature, and all preparation must be made and stored according to Imperial County health standards.
5. All ingredients must be edible. Ingredients may be canned or fresh. All Guacamoles must be "homemade."
6. No glass will be allowed in the cooking area.
7. Each contestant must make a minimum of one (1) gallon of Guacamole. Each contestant must submit one (1) pint container for judging, which will be provided at check-in time.
8. Each contestant will be allowed three (3) additional team members in their booth.
9. Each contestant will be assigned a number by the Chief Scorekeeper and will be given one pint container for the judging. The Chief Scorekeeper will collect these containers at 6:45 PM. It is the contestant's responsibility to make certain that the number on the container is the same as the contestant's assigned number.
10. No beer or other alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the fairgrounds. Any person or Team violating this rule will be disqualified from the event. Beer and alcoholic beverages may be purchased at the event.
11. The Fairgrounds staff will provide one table and two chairs for contestants.
12. Contestants will be responsible for supplying their own cooking utensils, ice chests, decorations, etc. A numbered area will be provided for each contestant.
13. All Guacamole must be prepared on site.
14. All ties will be resolved by the re-testing of the Guacamole recipe. Do not give all your Guacamole away, as you need to reserve a pint for judging.
15. Guacamole will be judged on appearance, aroma, taste, texture, originality/recipe – each in equal parts. **Recipe must be submitted with application.**
16. All ballots and tally sheets will be turned over to the Guacamole Contest staff after the judging has been completed.
17. Prizes will be offered for 1st through 3rd place as well as "Best Guacamole Booth" and a "Peoples Choice Guacamole".
18. Entries must be received in the fair office by Friday, February 29, 2008.
19. Prizes and Awards:
1st Place - **\$250.00** 2nd Place - **\$125.00** 3rd Place - **\$50.00**
Peoples Choice - Trophy ----- Trophy Best Booth - Trophy
